## *Remote Desktop & How To Use It*

Remote Desktop Connection is a technology that allows you to sit at a computer (sometimes called the *client* computer) and connect to a remote computer (sometimes called the *host* computer) in a different location.

*For example*, you can connect to your work computer from your home computer and have access to all of your programs, files, and network resources as though you were in front of your computer at work. You can leave programs running at work and then, when you get home, you can see your work computer's desktop displayed on your home computer, with the same programs running.

### **How do I install Remote Desktop Connection?**

Open Remote Desktop Connection by clicking the **Start** button , clicking **All Programs**, clicking **Accessories**, and then clicking **Remote Desktop Connection**.

How do I enable Remote Desktop Connection on the computer I want to connect to?

Open System by clicking the **Start** button , clicking **Control Panel**, clicking **System and Maintenance**, and then clicking **System**.

Click **Remote settings** on the left.

In the **System Properties** dialog box, under **Remote Desktop**, select the one of the three options, and then click **Select Users**.

If you are prompted for an administrator password or confirmation, type the password or provide confirmation. If you are an administrator on the computer, your current user account will automatically be added to the list of remote users and you can skip the next two steps.

In the **Remote Desktop Users** dialog box, click **Add**.

In the **Select Users or Groups** dialog box, do the following:

To specify the search location, click **Locations**, and then select the location you want to search.

In **Enter the object names to select**, type the name of the user that you want to add, and then click **OK**.

The name will be displayed in the list of users in the Remote Desktop Users dialog box.

Note: \*\*You can't connect to a computer that is sleeping or hibernating, so make sure the settings for sleep and hibernation on the remote computer are set to **Never**. (Hibernation is not available on all computers.) For information about making those changes, see Change, create, or delete a power plan (scheme).

You cannot use Remote Desktop Connection to connect to remote (host) computers running the following editions of Windows Vista:

- Windows Vista Starter
- Windows Vista Home Basic
- Windows Vista Home Basic N
- Windows Vista Home Premium

However, any edition of Windows Vista can be running on your computer (the one you want to connect *from*).

You cannot use Remote Desktop Connection to connect to remote computers running Windows XP Home either.

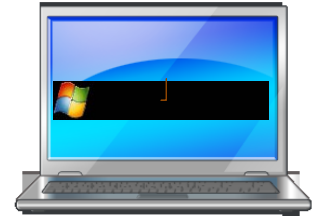
